Golfers tee off at home Monday

The 2004 season opens for the North Fayette golf teams Monday, April 5, against Clayton Ridge at the West Union Country Club.

Both the girls' and boys' teams have some quality golfers returning, and both squads feature good depth with 18 girls and 22 boys participating.

However, both teams return just three letter winners apiece.

The pals will try to defend their UIC crown with three All-Conference performers. Junior Lisa Horn was 6th

while seniors Kim Cannon and Nichole Fraumen finished 8th and 15th respectively at the UIC meet last May.

The three girls had season averages of 48.8, 50.6 and 49.4, respectively. As a team, the Hawks were 11-1 last year, losing only to Wanton.

Ahrens thinks the strongest competition for his champs are South West, Sumner, and Turkey Valley.

"It ought to be a tremendously competitive year," stated Ahrens. "I don't think anyone will be able to run away from the field."

The problem for Coach Ron Ahrens is to find some

people to fill in for the four seniors he lost.

Seniors Sarah James and Dacia Ostlundson have the experience. Sophomores Stephanie Miller (57) and Lauren Bruso (59) shot well last year.

Junior Carissa Kelly and sophomores Katie Schmitz and Allison Moschel played JV last year. Freshman Lisa Horn may also play her way into the picture.

Last year, the girls set five new team records. They also had all six girls make All-Conference for the second

straight year.

The girls had a team total record 178 for a 9-hole meet, and set the team record for season low scoring average with a 159.

THE BOYS also return three quality starters from their 10-2 season last year, when the boys were third in the UIC meet.

They also have a new coach as Greg James takes over the reins. The popular

band man coached women's golf for a couple of years in the mid-'80s.

Junior Chris Schrage was 3rd at that meet, sophomore Jesse Truax was 15th. For the season they averaged 43.3 and 42, respectively.

Adam Schueberger looks to do well his final season after not placing last year; he did shoot at a 42.3 average on the year.

Key to the year will be who steps up to fill the holes left by four departing seniors.

There are 24 boys with a wide range of skills trying to fill the holes.

James said, "It is still too soon to say who will be playing variety, but we have people with skills."

Whoever steps up to play variety ball this year will have some big shoes to fill.

The boys had four All-Conference performers, and their team score of 154 against O'Brien tied a school record.

The Hawks were 6th in the District with a team score of 345. Perennial state power Grundy Center (313) was first, followed by host Columbus and Hudson.

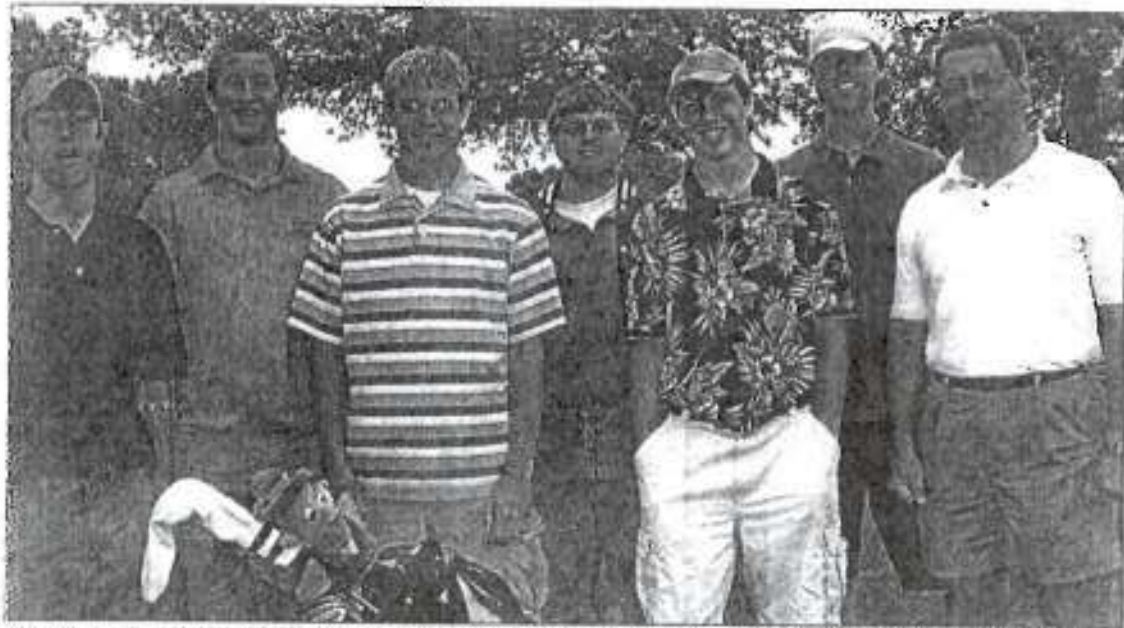
Jesse Truax and Chris Schrage led North Fayette with rounds of 82 apiece.
