North golfers greener than grass

The North Fayette boys' and girls' golf teams will be greener than the grass they play on to open the season.

The boys have no seniors and no lettermen, while the girls have a senior playing for the first time and two letter-winners.

The girls only have 10 players but may have the opening season edge with five experienced golfers on the roster.

Aubrey Davis and Ashley

Amos will be the leaders. "Davis was a leader last year, even though we had some quality seniors on the team," stated head coach Neal Bentley.

"Amos was coming on strong as a player and a leader at the end of last year and should be even better in both areas this year," he added.

Brianna Amos, Nichole Fagle, and Chesnee Franzen are younger players who look like they will contribute early in the season.

Jodie Miller is the lone senior. Taylor Huinker and Julie Harford are both in the

varsity mix.

According to Bentley, "Sumner-Fredericksburg looks to be the top of the UIC, with several teams not that far behind them."

As for his Hawks, Bentley stated, "We have a nice combination of leadership and skills in the group. We haven't been able to get on the course very much, but I'm looking forward to the season. I think we can make a lot of progress with the type of girls we have on the team."

The boys are even harder to handicap, since last year's team was virtually all seniors.

However, head coach Greg James has the numbers, with 17 boys competing for spots.

Landon Johansen, Tyler Pleggenkühle, and Dylan Langerman-Aten all cracked the varsity at times last year.

Eric Horn and Eric Van Horn both come from golfing families and can provide instant help.

Isaiah Solheim is a ninth-grader who is showing a nice touch early on.

James said, "It's a good group to work with and very competitive. We just got on the course Friday, and with

our youth, it will be hard to say how we will be in a month or so."

James expects Sumner-Fredericksburg to be strong, but also sees Clayton Ridge as a contender.

With so many young golfers, the North Fayette boys' golf team looks to have a bright future. As for this year, "It's hard at this point to make any real assessment. Everything depends upon how quickly we can put everything together. We could be very competitive by the end of the season," the coach concluded.

Golfers impress coaches; first home meet postponed

North Fayette golf teams had their home opener Monday night postponed due to the weather; no makeup date has been set.

The teams opened the season Thursday at Sumner against the Cougars.

Both the Sumner-Fredericksburg boys' and girls' teams are among the conference favorites.

While the young Hawks lost both games, NF coaches were impressed by how well their young players performed.

The Hawk girls lost, 204-277. Coach Bentley was pleased overall. "This was not only a first varsity meet for

some of the girls, it was the first time they have played a complete round of golf. And they did it on the home course of one of the best teams in the UIC."

Aubrey Davis was especially impressive with a team-best 59.

Freshman Chesnee Franzen carded a 63 on her first-ever varsity match.

Taylor Huinker shot a 76. Ashley Amos and Nichole Fagle both had 79s. Brianna Amos came in with an 89.

Medalist honors went to S-F's Kara Larson with a 42. The Cougars' Kaitlin Heller was runner-up with a 52.

Coach James was also

pleased, even though the boys lost, 157-185.

"The scores were lower than I might have predicted. It was the first meet ever for six of our 12 golfers, and the first time we've been able to putt on mowed greens."

Eric Horn and freshman Isaiah Solheim led the Hawks with identical 44s.

Dylan Langerman-Aten shot a 48, and Tyler Pleggenkuble completed the varsity scoring with a 49.

S-F's Nolan Nuss and Pat Kleman tied for medalist with rounds of 38.

The Hawk JV also lost, 171-216. Luke Bovy's 49 led the JV.
